Stuart Wightman's letter of 19 October refers. I know from discussion with Teri at our last teleconference meeting you are having internal discussion about audit visits etc in the context of your plans going forward. We have allocated £25k this November/December for additional audit visits and I think based on previous discussions you had indicated around £1,000 per audit visit. However, we wonder if there might be any economies of scale around this and if so how many visits might be possible with the £25k we have allocated?

The matter will be on our agenda for the next meeting but we wanted to give you a “**head up**” on the additional funding so that you could determine how this could best be utilised.

Our preference around audit visits as you know would be to aim for 1 in 10 perhaps as suggested in Stuart's letter initially targeted at those installations recording more than 400,000kWh annual hours.
