Further to my email yesterday, I have attached an updated version of your spreadsheet showing the data files that we are sending you through the secure GSi portal. The data is being sent in line with our data sharing protocols, as discussed on Monday.

It is worth mentioning that the meter reading data set includes all meter readings provided by the applicant. In a small number of cases, the meter readings maybe erroneous or inserted at our request to address a data fix issue in the system. In these instances we would have had dialogue with the customer and calculated and agreed their eligible heat output and payment for the period offline. If you have any questions or require any more detail on a particular RHI please let me know and we can provide further information.
