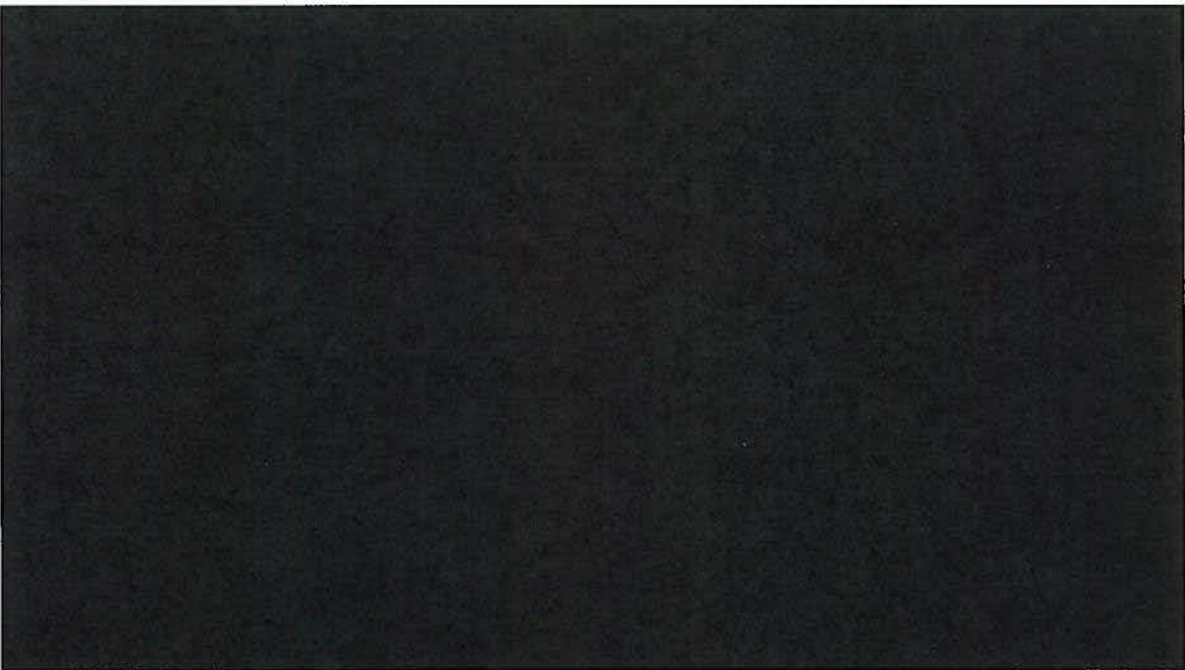
Hi Noelle,

I hope that you are keeping well. Thanks a million for sending these through and to Steven for asking the questions. It's a pleasure to be heard.

I had visited the RHI team in DETI a couple of weeks ago and they said the same i.e. that they assumed that renewables would've been undertaken in businesses as the last step after all energy efficiencies were maximised. I think that is a massive assumption. It looks like they've gone to the bother of promoting energy efficiency first with the domestic RHI but omitted that function for the commercial RHI. I see that they are trying to promote uptake, and perhaps for them this is the only way.

I've also got a meeting InvestNI's Sustainability team next month to highlight what we do. They focus heavily on renewables and process efficiencies, which is a great start, but not the full picture. Hopefully our presentation with them will make them see the wider potential for energy saving. They do a brilliant job, but my job is to ensure they know what we can do.
