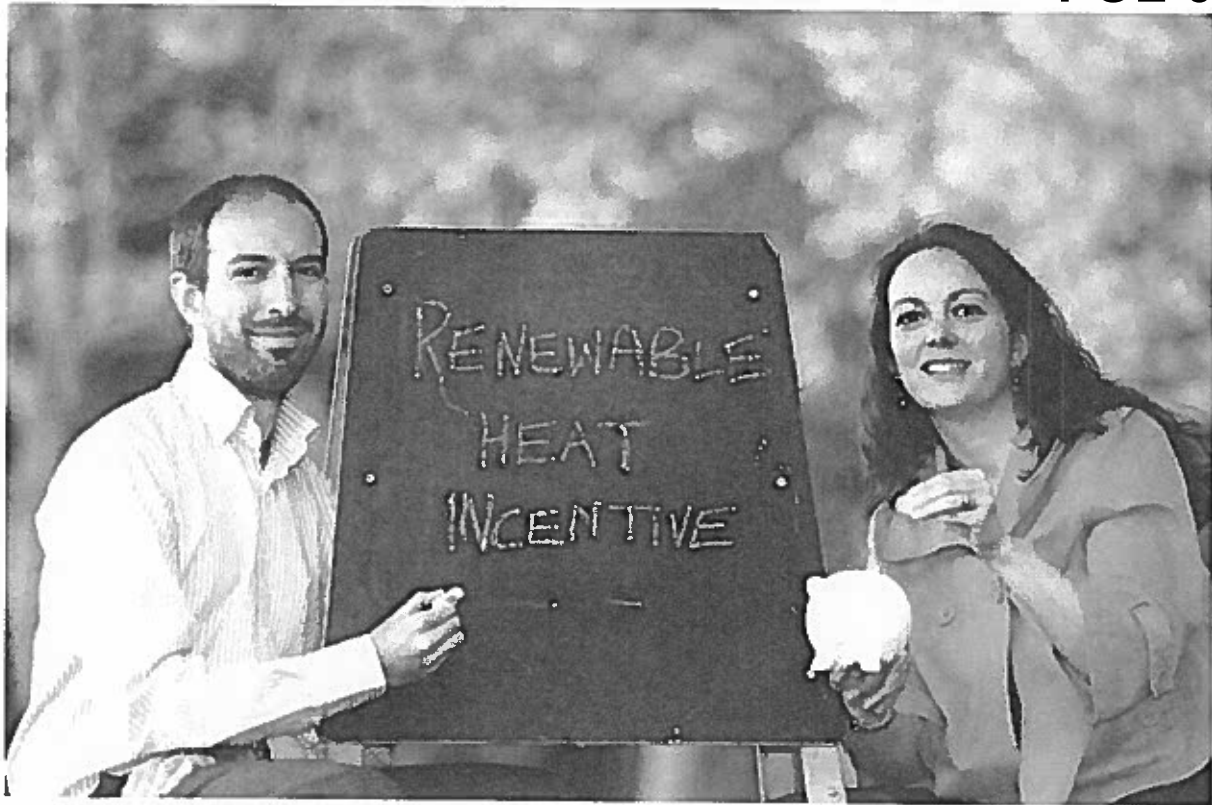

## Who will be speaking? What will they be speaking about?

Each speaker will give engaging insights into the RHI and outline its benefits to local businesses across Northern Ireland. Here is a short preview of who delegates can expect to hear from...**

### **Dr Edmund Ward, Senior Technical Manager, Ofgem**

Edmund works within Ofgem E-Serve, which administers the non-domestic Renewable Heat Incentive (RHI) on behalf of DETI in Northern Ireland and DECC in Great Britain. His responsibilities include approving applications made onto the scheme – for installations both large and small, and across the range of eligible renewable technologies. Edmund will give an overview of the RHI application process and break down the mechanics of the scheme.

**Gaynor Hartnell, Chief Executive, REA (Renewable Energy Association)**

Gaynor became the Chief Executive of the REA in early 2010, having been with the organisation since its formation in 2001. She has worked in the field of renewable energy since 1995, when she joined the British Wind Energy Association as Technical and Policy Analyst. Gaynor will be giving an overview of the how the RHI has been working in GB since its launch in November 2012 and will explore the lessons learned to date and outline the next steps of the scheme.

**Dr John Gilliland, OBE, Managing Director of Original Heating**

John is highly regarded, respected and globally recognised for his vision and leadership in the areas of sustainable development. John is a farmer, climate change and biomass expert and has been working in the renewables sector for over 25 years. John will be giving an insight into the benefits of biomass as a renewable fuel.

**Viscount Brookeborough**

Viscount Brookeborough runs a farm, estate and spa at his home, Colebrooke Park Country Estate, in County Fermanagh. He is President of Outward Bound NI and is a member of the Advisory Council of the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme in NI. He will also give an insight into what renewable technologies were installed at Colebrook Estate and Spa and the benefits he is now experiencing.
